SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

Your senior could be eligible to win an \$1,000 scholarship!

The Lee's Summit Chamber of Commerce Education Committee awards five \$1,000 scholarships each year to graduating high school seniors who have demonstrated a strong work ethic, commitment to community involvement and an endless pursuit of growth and improvement in all aspects of their lives.

One scholarship winner is selected from each of the three Lee's Summit public high schools, one from a Lee's Summit private high school, and one from a school outside the district.

The scholarships must be used within the same year they are received.



TRADES SCHOLARSHIP

Thanks to generous donors, the Chamber will offer a Trades Scholarship for a qualifying high school senior in 2024.

Eligible areas of vocational training include the construction trades (plumbing, electrical, carpentry and HVAC technician) as well as the culinary arts, cosmetology, automotive technology, agriculture, landscaping, medical, and other certificates from an accredited institution or program.

- Pursuing a higher education degree from an accredited institution
- Have a minimum 3.0 cumulative, unweighted GPA at 7th semester
- Have at least one parent or guardian working for a company/organization that is a member in good standing of the Lee's Summit Chamber of Commerce or be a student working for a Chamber member.
