## **ADVOCACY AT THE FOREFRONT** Chamber Board announces endorsements, opposition

The Lee's Summit Chamber Board of Directors recently announced its positions on a few matters affecting the Lee's Summit business community.

The Board voted unanimously to oppose a proposed landfill in south Kansas City, citing serious concerns over potential detrimental effects the landfill could pose. The proposed site is bordered by 147th Street to the north, Horridge Road to the east, 155th Street to the south and Peterson Road to the west.

"We are dedicated to enhancing and sustaining the economic vitality and quality of life in our community " -Matt Baird, President, LS Chamber

"Our members have invested considerable time, money and energy into choosing this area as a homebase for their businesses and we are committed to protecting their interests and creating an environment in which our business community can prosper," said Chamber President Matt Baird. "We are dedicated to enhancing and sustaining the economic vitality and quality of life in our community and will respectfully oppose any future

application for a landfill in this location that is so close to thousands of homes and multiple schools and businesses."

The Board also announced its support for the LSR7 No-Tax-Increase Levy Transfer appearing on the April 4, 2023, ballot.

"This ballot initiative is extremely vital to the growth, development and future of Lee's Summit," Baird said. "The LSR7 School District is a key component to the success of the Lee's Summit community and by approving this transfer we can enable salary increases for LSR7 employees to recruit and retain quality staff and ensure we are staying competitive in the hiring market of regional public school districts."

Lastly, the Board announced its endorsement for the City of Lee's Summit's notax-increase bond projects ballot initiatives appearing on the April 4, 2023 ballot.

The bonds include a no-tax-increase public safety and emergency preparedness bond project and initiative totaling \$74 million; a no-tax-increase transportation bond project and initiative totaling \$98 million; and a no-tax-increase general municipal bond project and initiative totaling \$14 million.

"Part of the attraction for businesses to come to Lee's Summit is all that the city offers - from public safety to our beautiful parks system, the development of our thriving downtown and the developments currently happening across our community" Baird said.

"The City will be able to ensure our city is a top attraction for business development and growth by capitalizing on this revenue. We encourage the citizens of Lee's Summit and our business community to show their support by voting 'yes' on April 4."
